

Scuba Diving in Vietnam with Right Equipment

Scuba diving is surely the most exciting under water sport when you travel to Vietnam and apply [Vietnam visa](#) online. Swimming amid the beautiful marine creatures and watching the marvelous view of the under-water wildlife is something to die for. But, before you jump into the water with the sheer zeal and enthusiasm to be familiar with the under-water world, be sure that you carry the essential kits to enjoy the maximum out of this water expedition.

The scuba diving equipment can be purchased or rented from a pro shop in Vietnam. These must haves are:

Snorkel:

Snorkel conserves the air into the tank allowing you to breathe while swimming on the surface. This snorkel should be about 17 inches long fitted close to your head. The price of the snorkel is about \$20. You have to purchase it as they are not rented.

Mask:

Purchase a high-quality mask which helps to clear the underwater vision. It should be properly fitted and made of tempered-glass lens plate. It can be designed to accommodate the eyeglasses.

Buoyancy Control Device (BCD)

It is the air bladder which can be inflated or deflated according to your buoyancy needs. It helps to ascend or descend into the water.

Fins:

Fin makes the whole maneuvering process smoother. Fins come in different design. This rubber or the plastic equipments can be fitted with the adjustable straps which allow wearing the wetsuit boots comfortably. You find the fins between \$ 150- \$ 200.

Wetsuit:

Wetsuits keep your body warm. This wetsuit is available in different thicknesses. The thicker the suit is, the warmer you feel. And the thickness will depend on the temperature of the water, your cold tolerance and whether you are diving in saltwater or fresh water.

Tank:

You can rent the scuba tank as it needs to be inspected on yearly basis. It is used for holding the air under the high pressure. A fully filled tank contains around 3000 PSI of pressure.

The Regulator:

This is the mouth piece attached to the tank. It helps to breathe under water. They release the air when you inhale. They come in pair, one is for you and the other is for emergency use. With that, computers and diving gauges should be purchased to tell how deep you are.

So, let's dive into the water to enjoy the underwater magic in Vietnam.
